Water conditions

This week's map, for conditions as of April 29, shows a decrease in drought area—most of the Panhandle and parts of North, Central, and East Texas saw one category of improvement. Since late March, drought has contracted four of the last five weeks.

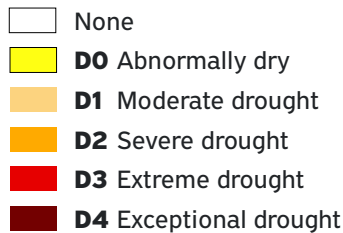

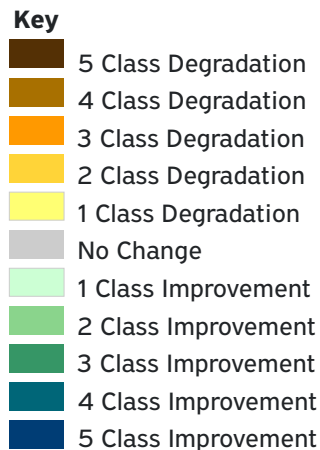

Drought change in the last month

In the last five weeks, drought area in the state contracted from 70 percent on March 25 to 53 percent on April 29. Many areas in North and South Texas experienced at least one category of improvement during that time. Drought remains entrenched in Central and West Texas.
