
Water Weekly For the week of **05/19/25 Water conditions** This week's map, for conditions as of May 13, shows continued contraction of drought. The area of the state impacted by drought has reached its lowest value since October 2024. U.S. seasonal drought outlook

Since early March, drought expanded from 54 percent of the state to 70 percent and then contracted to 41 percent this week. In the next three months (through the end of August) the National Weather Service expects drought to persist at its current extent in Texas.
